

A Vision for Kumamoto Science Park (March 2025)


1 Philosophy

1) Extended Science Park
Our goal is to expand the Semiconductor
Technology Park to nearby areas. By
expanding industrial and residential facilities,
we aim to create multiple technology centers
in the area.

2) Policy for regional development
We plan to use land-use development projects
to enhance prefectural and municipal
cooperation. This will help establish and
expand the Science Park.


2 Main Points
